Plot	A young, restless badger Frances is put to bed early.
Setting	Bedtime for little badgers, 7 pm Frances's house Childhood
Characters	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Frances, a young badger • Mother • Father
Conflict	Man vs. Himself- Frances must go to sleep, but is wakeful and fearful. Man vs. Man – Frances must learn to obey her parents.
Theme	Frances must learn self-control and obedience in spite of her desire to be up late with her parents and the scary noises in the night.
Literary Devices	<p>Onomatopoeia – “Bump and thump. His wings smacked the glass. Whack and smack! Whack and smack made Frances think of a spanking...”</p> <p>Repetition</p> <p>Rhyme and Meter – in Frances's inimitable songs</p>
