Cavitica– an old grey barn spider who becomes Wilbur's friend Templeton – the barn rat Homer Zuckerman – Fern's uncle who houses Wilbur in his barn Edith Zuckerman – Fern's aunt Lurvy – Homer's farm hand Henry Fussy – Fern's beau Farm Animals who populate the barnyard where Wilbur and Charlotte live
