<i>Plot</i>	Disaster ensues when Dr. Jekyll discovers a potion which separates the nature of man into its two parts, good and evil.
<i>Setting</i>	The Soho district of London in the 1880s.
<i>Characters</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dr. Jekyll – protagonist • Mr. Hyde – antagonist and alter ego of Jekyll • Poole – Jekyll’s groom/ servant • Utterson – narrator of the story and longtime friend of Jekyll and Lanyon. He serves as the witness to the case. • Lanyon – doctor and old friend of Jekyll, a second witness to the fantastical narrative.
<i>Conflict</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Man vs. Himself • Man vs. Man • Man vs. Nature • Man vs. God
<i>Theme</i>	The strength of sin. The danger of pride. The nature of man.
<i>Literary Devices</i>	Story frame (a story within a story)
